Our hotel sources its Mourne Honey from a local bee guru who operates a small apiary close by. The bees gather their pollen and nectar from the wonderful Mourne 'Bell and Ling Heathers' on a good year, and also from Fushia, Sycamore, Dandelion, Bramble, Clover, and Blackberry bushes. The honey is harvested by hand using a spinner to extract the honey from the wax frames.
